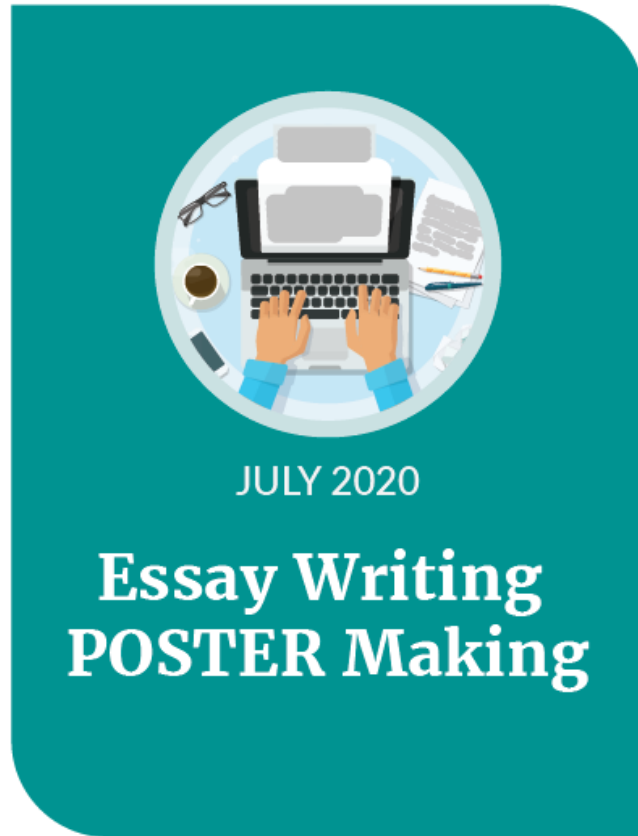
World Youth Skills Day

Program Guidelines

Essay Writing Competition Rules:

1. The essay must not be longer than 500 words.
2. The essay must highlight the students' perspective about the necessity of 21st Century Skills for a better world tomorrow.
3. The essay must highlight the different 21st century skills and youth's role in developing that.
4. The essay must not present itself in any politically controversial light.
5. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the entry.
6. E- Certificates of participation and winners will be shared with the schools. Names of winners will be published in AFS Weekly

Poster Making Competition Rules:

1. The poster may be made using any medium of paints and colours - digital or on paper. The poster must be made on an A4 sheet if on paper.
2. The poster may not have captions of more than 15 words.
3. The poster must be an original ideation of the student. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the entry.
4. The poster must be sent as a high-quality image to be considered for prizes.
5. E- Certificates of participation and winners will be shared with the schools. Names of winners will be published in AFS Weekly.
