

SESSION: 2025-2026

All parents, students and staff must compulsorily read and ensure that the Rules and Regulations are followed in the interest of caring for the students to the best of our ability.

1. Attendance:

A minimum of 90% attendance is mandatory. Any student whose attendance is below this is liable to be debarred from appearing for the final examination.

2. Leave & Visitors:

- a. Students will be allowed leave only on outings specified in the school calendar.
- b. Making a request for leave is no guarantee of leave being granted.
- c. Overnight outings on notified leave days are permitted only with parents or grandparents. They are expected to carry their visitor's card or authority letter with them.
- d. Students will not be allowed to check out unless she has a valid Permission Slip issued by the House Mistress/Tutor. Students will not be allowed to check out or check in unless she is accompanied by a person authorised by her parents. This person must have a valid Government photo ID and a valid Permission Slip issued by the House Mistress/Tutor for check out.
- e. Any student reporting late after the sanctioned leave will have to wait for the school to communicate another date for check-in. This date may be several weeks later than the original date of return.
- f. Absence during the term is not in the interest of the students. Leave of absence will be granted only in case of an emergency.
- g. A student who is granted medical leave after following due process, for grave medical conditions, should submit the medical certificate on the day of joining the school. All necessary documents: Doctor's

prescription, medical reports, RT PCR etc. should be submitted to the infirmary for further reference. If the RMO is not convinced with the health reports, the student will not be checked in. Admission of such students will be reviewed by the school and she may have to withdraw from the school on medical grounds.

i. All leave applications must be addressed to the HM well in advance and sent by the parents only on the school's official email ID.

3. Correspondence:

- All correspondence should be addressed to the House Mistress. The student's class, house and school code number should be clearly mentioned.
- b. Any change of address or telephone number must be notified to the Principal, Vice Principal, HM and Admissions In charge through mail.

4. Communication:

- a. Going to a boarding school is a major transition for the child and the family. It is essential to have regular communication with the student as well as her teachers and the Pastoral Staff.
- b. The parents can communicate with the Pastoral Staff on the numbers given in the Calendar.
- c. The school has a Call Budgeting System (CBS). Boarders are allowed 36 minutes talk time every week /144 minutes per month. The account is recharged every Sunday. The students can speak on the two numbers given by the Parents, according to the schedule decided by the school. If a student is found misusing this system, she might not be permitted to use it.
- d. The CBS lines will open for use by students one week after check in from Summer, Diwali and Winter Vacations

5. Payment of fee:

The school dues must be paid in time so as to enable the student to appear for the Mid Term and Annual Examination.

I Installment -

Between 15 th March and 31 st March (for new admissions as per date given in the offer letter)

II Installment -

Between 1st September and 15th September Delay in payment of fee will result in penalty.

6. Allocation of Houses:

Allocation of Houses to the students will be done at the discretion of the school.

7. Personal Belongings:

- a. All personal belongings should be clearly marked with the student's name and school code. The students wearing spectacles should bring two spare pairs of spectacles with them.
- b. Students are not permitted to have Mobiles/Tablets/Laptops/screen based I Pods/ Speakers/ expensive jewellery and cosmetics in their possession.
- c. Students are not permitted to bring electric gadgets like iron, hot water kettle, boilers, heating pads, hair straighteners, etc.
- d. Students should carry only those clothes or items mentioned in the Kit List.
- e. I Pods without screens are permitted but should be deposited with the HM and collected only on weekends.
- f. Polaroid cameras are not permitted.
- g. School will not take the responsibility of personal cameras brought by the students. However, in case students bring their personal cameras, they need to be deposited with the HM.
- h. Students are not permitted to use social media during their stay in the school. Any post regarding school and specially the students on

unauthorised media handles may be reported to cyber cells of the government.

8. Areas Out of Bounds:

The school routine involves physical & other activities during the course of which a girl may be exposed to accidental injuries in spite of all precautions. The school will not be held responsible for any such eventualities.

The following places remain out of bounds for all students:

- i) All roofs and terraces
- ii) All labs unless supervised by faculty
- iii) Kitchen, stores and staff room vii) Forest Area
- iv) Staff Quarters

- v) Academic Block other than study hours
- vi) Swimming Pool (Except under supervision)
- viii) All entry and exit gates of the school
- ix) Boarding houses during school hours/games/activities/prep

Students are not permitted to practise for events at venues and times which have not been sanctioned. They should not stay out of their Houses for practices without staff escorts.

9. Disobedience of school regulations:

- Disobedience of school regulations and acts of gross misbehaviour may attract consequences of suspension or withdrawal from school. An errant student's parents will be asked to keep the student under personal care outside the school after course completion, to prepare and appear for home examination as per the decision of the school or Board examination under their own arrangement.
- The School has a zero-tolerance policy regarding substance abuse or b. use of addictive substances including alcohol, cigarette, e-cigarette and tobacco. Any student found in possession of the same or indulging in the same will be expelled from the school with immediate effect.
- Carrying of mobile phones is strictly prohibited. If found, the school c.

will not be held responsible for any such eventuality. The phone will be confiscated permanently. Repetition of this act may result in suspension/dismissal.

- d. Students who are not punctual for any class, activity period or games, will be marked late in the Attendance Register. This will be communicated to the parents.
- e. Loitering in the school parks, corridors, etc. during school hours is prohibited.
- f. Leaning/Sliding on the bannisters is strictly prohibited.
- g. Students must be very careful about their books and stationery. Students who are negligent will be charged for lost or spoiled articles by debit to their personal account.
- h. The Principal may, at any time, require a parent to withdraw their child from the school and reserves the right to dismiss any student if she considers it is in the interest of the school and /or student, especially for the following issues:
 - i) For substance abuse
 - ii) For breach of discipline
 - iii) For repeated detention in class
 - iv) For conduct that sets a bad example for others
 - v) For bringing disrepute to the school
 - vi) For indulging in any behaviour or act that may be constituted as ragging, abetting ragging, actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging. Bullying is strictly prohibited inside the school campus and no such act will go unnoticed and unpunished.
 - vii) For child indulging in self-harm
- i. Visitors /Parents are requested to deposit their mobile phones at the security office on the gate. They should not, under any circumstances, lend it to any other student to use.

j. No verbal assurance of any nature, allegedly given by any member of the Staff, will be accepted as binding on the school.

10. Security:

Students' security is a prime concern of the school. Security guards' man the Main Gate, Boarding Houses and Academic Block round the clock. Lady Guards have been deputed at various locations around the campus: in the Academic Block and in the Boarding House premises. They are under instruction to question the visitors/students about the purpose of their visit, the person being visited, etc. Guards have been asked to be courteous, polite but firm because they do not have the authority to permit entry to anyone unless he/she has permission from the higher authorities. However, it has been our experience that some parents/visitors get involved in arguments with the Guard. You are requested to avoid getting into such embarrassing situations.

11. Health:

- a. In case the medical documents of a student submitted by the parents at the time of admission are not found in order or a medical issue is noticed. The medical authority of the school may on medical grounds declare the student unfit for admission in the boarding school which will lead to cancellation of the admission.
- b. A cumulative health record for each boarder is maintained in the infirmary. At the time of admission, a student's record must be completed by a physician and duly signed by the parents. The school must be kept informed of any illness occurring during the vacation so that it can be entered in the record along with details of the medication given.
- c. Children are not permitted to keep any medication with them. Any boarder taking homeopathic medicine must inform the Nursing Sister/Doctor.
- d. Permission for midterm medical checkups will be granted only in exceptional cases or on the advice of our school doctor. Dates for such consultations should be taken after approval of RMO.

- e. Parents are advised to have their child's eyesight tested once during every vacation.
- f. Immunization of the students is the sole responsibility of parents.
- g. In the event of a student contracting a communicable ailment (e.g. Chicken pox) or one that has protracted treatment (e.g. jaundice), parents will have to keep her under their care until complete recovery.

12. Money and Tuck:

- a. Boarders are not permitted to keep money in their possession. Pocket money will be issued by the school whenever required. Any cash found in a student's possession will be confiscated. In case of travelling alone, the money brought, during check in, should be deposited with the House Mistress.
- b. No tuck is permitted, except Bournvita / Hot chocolate/ Milo / Horlicks / Boost. Any Eatables/Snacks sent through post or courier or with the student after the vacation will be confiscated. These and confiscated money will be sent as charity to orphanages and blind schools supported by our school.
- c. Dry Fruits should be sent in small packets for daily consumption and must be submitted by the students at the nursing station. The students will take their daily dose from there.
- d. Toiletries are supplied through the school tuck shop. All toiletries required for the beginning of the term must be sent by the parents with the students. Parents are advised not to send toiletries during the term and encourage the students to avail the school's tuck shop facility.
- e. Boarders are not allowed to have any dealings with the photographer, any other vendor or office peon for any purchase.

13. Parcels:

Parcels, online-shopping packages or other items are not permitted.

14. Uniforms:

a. During school hours students must be in school uniform.

- b. Each girl is required to carry clothing as per the kit list provided. No other garments will be accepted through parcels during the term.
- c. Garments such as miniskirts, tight pants, sleeveless or strappy blouses and T-shirts are not allowed to be worn on the school campus.
- d. Shoes or sandals with high heels are not permitted.
- e. Students are not permitted to wear streaks, coloured /dyed hair or long and painted nails.
- f. Students will leave the school only in school uniform/Travel Kit issued by school while going on vacation with their parents. They must report back to school in school uniform/Travel Kit.

15. Passport:

Since the school is a member of international organizations like Round Square and AFS, there are many opportunities to travel abroad for conferences and exchanges. Kindly see that your daughter has a valid passport in order to avail such opportunities.

16. Airport Drop:

- a. Gwalior airport drop is not permitted except during scheduled school leaves. Students will not be checked out or checked in without a person authorized by Parents.
- b. School escorted Delhi Party travel will be facilitated for Summer Vacations, Diwali Vacations and Winter Vacations. Parents are required to give their consent for travel alone to & fro from Delhi to their home destination

17. Birthdays:

- a. Birthday Parties are organized by the HMs and celebrated in the houses. The amount to be spent by the student for her birthday will be approved by the school authorities from time to time.
- b. There are no outings or visits permitted on birthdays. Kindly refrain from such requests.
- c. Birthday chocolates can be ordered from the School Tuck Shop. Sending flowers, gifts, birthday cakes, or any eatables is not allowed.

18. Classroom Ethics:

- a. Class room furniture and Lockers must be kept neat & tidy.
- b. Before leaving the classroom, the students must switch off all fans, lights and smartboards.
- c. Students should submit their classwork and homework note books regularly for correction and these will be scrutinized by the Principal and the Vice Principal regularly.

19. School Ethics:

- a. Students must not pluck flowers or fruits in the compound.
- b. Students must always greet teachers and visitors. They should always be courteous and respectful to every member of the staff.
- c. Students should not enter the Principal's room or the Staffroom without permission. Loitering outside the office room is also prohibited. Students should not go to any of the staffquarters in the school compound, except on special occasions and with the permission of the Principal or the House Mistress.
- d. No students should go to the House or Infirmary during school hours or Games /Activity time. In case of necessity, permission must be obtained from the teacher.
- e. Students should not enter the Swimming Pool except during the hours and days fixed. Swimming will be done only under the supervision of the Physical Education Teachers.
- f. Students should not bring any utensils or crockery to their rooms or school from the dining hall.

20. Signing the Document:

Whenever a student is required to sign any paper, she should sign it after fully understanding it and should put the date.

21. Suggestions:

Difficulties experienced by the students and suggestions for improving their welfare can be brought to the notice of the Principal through the Vice Principal, House Mistress, Tutor, Class teacher, subject teachers, counsellors or doctor.

22. Withdrawal:

- a. For the students who do not intend to continue the next academic session commencing in April, must submit the withdrawal application in the school on or before 31st December, minimum 3 months prior to the new session. The withdrawal application that is received on or after 1st January, the 1st term fee of the upcoming session will become applicable on them in lieu of the notice period.
- b. The parents who wish to withdraw their ward after appearing for the AISSE, should send a written application to this effect before 31st December, minimum 3 months prior to the new session. If the withdrawal application is received on or after 1st January, the 1st term fee of the upcoming new session will become applicable on them in lieu of the notice period.
- c. If a student admitted in the school withdraws during the term, the entire term fee paid will be forfeited.
- d. The Transfer certificate and other documents will be issued only after the clearance formalities are completed including clearance of dues.
- e. For students who withdraw or pass out from classes X & XII respectively. The T.C with board documents will be issued after the board results are declared and the documents are received from the board, and completion of clearance of dues.
- f. The school leaving certificate has a fee. A duplicate certificate will be issued on request against an additional payment.
- g. Caution money will be refunded in the next session by 30th October following the session in which the student has left the school, and only to those for whom school leaving certificate has been issued.

A calendar is issued to each student at the beginning of the academic year. Parents must refer to the calendar for information relating to School functions, holidays, Parent-Teacher meetings and schedule of tests and examinations. However, these dates are subject to change.
